

Hey Barracudas,

This is it - the last meet of the 2010 season! We will be swimming "Champs" this Sunday, June 27th, at the University of Texas's swim center. There will be three sessions; U6 and U8/U10 in the morning and the big kids in the afternoon. The U6 will swim in one pool. Everyone else will be split into boys' and girls' pools.

Here is the timeline for the three sessions:

U6

6:30 - swimmers meet under the big tree in front of the swim center
6:45 - swimmers enter the center
7:00 - warmups
7:30 - warmups over; organize for relay teams/1st events
7:45 - session begins
9:15 - Session 1 completed, clear the deck.

U8 & U10

8:45 - swimmers meet under the big tree in front of the swim center
9:15 - swimmers enter the center
9:30 - warmups
9:55 - warmups over; organize for relay teams/1st events
10:00 - session begins
12:45 - Session 2 completed, clear the deck.

11 and Up

12:45 - swimmers meet under the big tree in front of the swim center
1:00 - swimmers enter the center
1:15 - warmups
1:45 - warmups over; organize for IM/1st events
2:00 - session begins
4:45 - Session 3 completed, clear the deck.

There is no free parking at UT. You can drop your swimmers off in front of the swim center, but you cannot park in the lot without a UT permit. You can park for \$10 in the UT Trinity&MLK parking garage (across MLK from the swim center) or you can park for free in the State parking garages south of MLK (a couple of blocks walk to the swim center). Don't try to park on UT, you **will** get a ticket.

Heat sheets will be posted on the CCSL website. There will be a link from the SAAB site. There will not be any deck entries or last minute changes to heat sheets. Final heat sheets should be available Friday evening. Please print a copy for yourself.

Only swimmers and registered volunteers are allowed on deck. Spectators must remain in the stands; parents will NOT be allowed on deck unless they are also volunteering in a session. There will be Marshals and UT personnel at the deck entrance to enforce this.

Swimmers, the coaches will tell you where your warmup lanes are. Be sure to listen to your coaches.

Volunteers, listen for announcements for your pre-session meetings - usually 15-30 minutes before the start of the session. Zoo Keepers, please move away from the Ready Bench after you have delivered your swimmers. Otherwise it gets too crowded around the Ready Bench.

Times will be immediately posted on the score boards at each end after each heat. Meet results will be posted on the CCSL website after the meets. There will be a link from the SAAB site. Awards will be handed out at the end-of-season banquet on Tuesday, June 29th.

The swim center has a concession stand and a merchandise shop (for those last minute goggles and UT warmups). Due to the restricted zoo areas, there will be a community cooler. You can also provide light snacks for you swimmer.

There is no Lost&Found at UT. If you forget it, UT immediately throws it away! (They get way too many items to try to keep a Lost&Found.)
